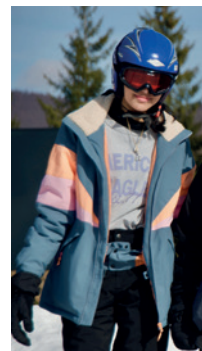


To Study
